

RHS Tatton Flower Show Cheshire Bonsai Society Exhibit 21 July 2018

This was the 20th year of the RHS Tatton Flower Show. To celebrate their attendance at every show since it started, Cheshire Bonsai Society decided to put on a larger than usual stand, ten metres in width. The stand exhibited a wide variety of species in a range of sizes and three Tokonomas, two of which contained Shohin displays. All were very much appreciated by visitors to the stand.

The judges recognised Cheshire Bonsai Society's achievement with a gold medal and were highly complementary of the quality of the trees and the endeavour put in by the society's members. The society has won an RHS award every year, this being their ninth gold in the last ten years.

The Chairman of the society said, "We were very pleased not only to receive a gold medal but also that the public loved our stand as it is always our aim to create a greater interest in the art of bonsai. Considering that this was the biggest stand we have put on in twenty years of showing at Tatton the standards achieved by the society are first class.
